Response: If this is so, then God lies. *If this is so, God tells Mohammed one thing and the Apostle Paul something else.* In this case...we serve a malevolent God. If this is so....Jesus lied.

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.(John 14:6)
